Lessons include the placement of the chock blocks and trailer tires, the arrangement of pallets in order to distribute the load properly, and checks required before driving into a trailer at a dock site. Courses likewise consist of Material Safety Data Sheet (or MSDS) training. Though not directly related to the utilization of a lift truck, MSDS training is important if an operator notices a leaking container or damages a container containing toxic materials. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on people and right methods of handling spills.
